Pharm) (0-60) degree course from the academic year 2023-24.

In this Connection, I am to inform you that the Higher and Technical Education Department, Government of Maharashtra vide शासन मान्यता-२०२३/प्र.क्र. ५७/तांशि-४, दिनांक १७ ऑगस्ट, २०२३ has given permission to start New **Pharmacy College** in the name of "**Bombay Institute of Pharmacy and Research, Next to Lodha Panacea, Near Jain Temple, Bhadra Nagar, Desalepada, Dombivali (E)-400 612**" for Bachelor of Pharmacy (B. Pharm) (0-60) degree course from the academic year 2023-24 on **permanently no grant basis** under the provisions of Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 under section 109, subject to terms and condition laid down in the above order.

I am therefore, directed to inform you that, your Trust has been granted permission to start New **Pharmacy College** in the name "**Bombay Institute of Pharmacy and Research, Next to Lodha Panacea, Near Jain Temple, Bhadra Nagar, Desalepada, Dombivali (E)-400 612**" for Bachelor of Pharmacy (B. Pharm) (0-60) degree course from the academic year 2023-24 on **permanently no grant basis** on the fulfillment of conditions mentioned in the above referred letters Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi, Government of Maharashtra, and the following affiliation conditions:

1. That the conditions laid down by the University from time to time
2. That the minimum attendance of all the students must not be less than 75% during the academic year and college will have to complete the syllabus of all the subjects during the academic year.
3. Admission should not be linked with donation.
4. That the college will strictly follow the Ordinance 2802 in respect of preventing the colleges and Management of colleges from accepting donation or capitation fee for the admission of students in the colleges quoted in the University Circular No. Aff./Recog/49 of 1987 dated 4th February, 1987 (Copy enclosed)
5. That college should follow the norms as prescribed and circulated by the University vide circular No. CONCOL/75 of 1988 dated 3rd March, 1988 (Copy enclosed)
6. That the college should not admit the students over and above sanctioned intake.
7. The college shall appoint the teaching as well as non-teaching faculty as per the University and UGC norms and also provided infrastructure facilities for the purpose.
8. That the college will submit no objection certificate for starting new college from other colleges in nearby area.
9. That college should follow the norms as prescribed and circulated by the University vide circular No. Aff/Recog/ICC/2012-13/17 dated 24th August, 2012 (Copy enclosed)
10. That college should follow the norms as prescribed and circulated by the University vide circular No. Aff/ICC/(2018-19)/43 of 2018 dated 25th October, 2018 (Copy enclosed)
